Registration Policies: All camp registrations must be paid in full. We are unable to refund lunch fees. Schedule changes may be made depending on availability, subject to a change fee of \$25 per camper per week. Registrations may be cancelled up to two weeks before the start of a session; refunds, minus a \$25 administration fee, will be in the form of a credit on your JCC account.

Summer 2022 Health and Safety

Creating and maintaining a healthy and safe environment for everyone has always been and remains our top priority. As we focus on this coming summer, we continue to learn, study and monitor guidance provided by local and state health agencies, and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

As is the case every year, we are striving to improve every aspect of camp operations. COVID-19 requires additional attention in this area and a shift in processes and procedures for this summer.

The response, recommendations and guidelines of our health and safety plans are subject to and will likely change as we continue to learn more. As more data and research is available and related protocols established, this information will be updated.

This guide is primarily intended for parents of current or prospective campers. Staff will be following much of the same standards outlined below and will also receive individualized COVID-19 plans prior to the start of summer.

Some images shown throughout this brochure do not represent current operational guidelines or health and safety measures such as face coverings and social distancing requirements.

Cleanliness & Hygiene

Several changes will be in effect to increase sanitation and maintain safety related to limiting the spread of COVID-19. In addition to increased signage that illustrate best practices to mitigate the spread of the virus and clarify expectations, campers will see:

- Increased number of hand sanitizer stations placed throughout camp with a focus on entries to buildings and high traffic areas.
- Space and time devoted to regular handwashing before and after meals, between
 activities and prior to use of shared spaces.
- Drinking fountains will be closed and an increased number of water bottle filling stations will be added around camp. Campers will be instructed to carry their water bottles around with them. Drinking stations will be cleaned regularly.



Communication

We commit to keeping our families informed and will always be open and available for questions. Should you have questions, concerns or ideas on COVID-19 and Summer 2022 or wish to discuss anything in this document further, please email us at camp@rosenjcc.org.

During camp, there will be visual reminders of ways to reduce the spread of COVID-19. Upon arrival, COVID-19 protocols and procedures will be reviewed in detail with campers in an age-appropriate way.

Should your camper be considered high risk, it is imperative that you communicate with us so we can properly plan and accommodate their needs.

Facilities Management

The cleanliness and safety of our facilities is something in which we take great pride. Our facilities team works tirelessly to maintain camp and keep everything running smoothly. In addition to our standard cleaning procedures, the facilities team will partner with camp staff to ensure our entire facility is safe for the camp community. - Common spaces, including common bathrooms, will be cleaned and sanitized regularly throughout the day.
- All campers and staff will be required to wash hands as they enter the building, before lunch, after playground time, and in-between activities as they enter and exit their classrooms.

Meals & Extended Care



All camps include an afternoon snack around 2 p.m. Campers may bring or purchase a lunch; snacks and ice cream are also available for purchase at lunchtime. Lunches may not include peanuts or tree nuts.

Lunches, snacks and ice cream can be prepaid on a weekly basis. Snacks and ice cream can also be purchased daily with cash. There is no ice cream or snack available for purchase on field trip days.

Extended Care

Need care beyond the regular camp day of 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.? Our extended care program for campers in all youth camps allows you to drop off as early as 7 a.m. and pick up as late as 6:00 p.m. Our counselors will be there to run fun games and activities!

There are always multiple elective track options, and they may vary from week to week. Elective options may include: drama, sports, games, music, art, and fitness. Special events, field trips, and access to the splash pad round out the summer to provide a comprehensive camp program for all grades, where campers gain new experiences and build lasting friendships. Junior Varsity (Grades K-3) and Varsity (Grades 4-8) Sports Variety Camps are our special sports elective programs for campers seeking an active, athletic experience at camp. Coaches provide instruction and challenge campers through drills and scrimmages in a variety of sports such as basketball, hockey, baseball, kickball, soccer, volleyball, and more. Campers are grouped based on grade and skill level to ensure fair play and appropriate instruction. Both Junior and Varisty campers round out the Summer with field trips and access to the splash pad to provide a comprehensive camp program where campers gain new experiences and build lasting friendships.

We want your child to be a safe, confident and happy swimmer! That's why at the Rosen JCC Swim Camp, our instructors are committed to providing swim instruction in a safe, fun and nurturing environment. Campers will receive individualized instruction in a group setting based on their swimming ability. Our swim instructors are trained to teach each group level. Each camper will receive a Certificate of Completion at the end of their camp session and parents will receive a report card to keep them informed of the camper's swimming ability. Our camps are open to children in grades K-6! Campers will be grouped into three levels — beginner, intermediate, advanced — based on their skill level.

Brightwheel

We use Brightwheel as the primary communication platform during the summer. This is where we communicate important information you need to know about camp, as well as any daily or weekly updates. Please check your Brightwheel account regularly during the summer for the most up-to-date information on your camper's summer experience.

Parent Email Addresses

Almost all of our communication with families comes through email or via our website. We must have a valid email address for the family of each registered camper. This is the only way to guarantee that you receive important announcements and updates from us. Also, please add info@rosenjcc.com to your address book or safe list to ensure that our emails will not be blocked as spam. If you are not certain that we have a correct email address for your family, please call our Welcome Center at 407.387.5330.

JCC Emails

Both the Rosen JCC and Camp J use special software to send emails to large numbers of people or groups. By having campers at Camp J, your family is part of the JCC community and will receive emails from both Camp J and the Rosen JCC. It is important that you do not "opt-out" of receiving JCC emails. Opting out of these emails will prevent you from receiving important information regarding Camp J programs, updates, and news. DROP OFF & PICK-UP

There will be a carpool drop off line with the guidance of our staff to snake through the entrance off of Apopka-Vineland Rd to the oval in front of the building. There will be signage around the parking lot directing parents/guardians where to go. A map will also be distributed to everyone electronically. We are asking that parents/guardians remain in their cars and a Rosen JCC staff member will escort campers into the building.
