Registration Policies:

All camp registrations must be paid in full. Schedule changes may be made depending on availability, with an additional fee of \$25 per camper per week. We require a two-week written notice to cancel a week of camp. All refunds, minus \$25 cancellation fee, will be issued to your JCC account for future programming. Same day registrations will be an additional \$50. Lunches are non-refundable.





Lunches & Snacks

All camps include an afternoon snack around 2 p.m. Campers may bring or purchase a lunch; snacks and ice cream are also available for purchase at lunchtime. Lunches may not include peanuts or tree nuts.

Lunches, snacks and ice cream can be prepaid on a weekly basis. Snacks and ice cream can also be purchased daily with cash. There is no ice cream or snack available for purchase on field trip days.

Brightwheel

We use the Brightwheel app as the primary communication platform during the summer. This is where we communicate important information you need to know about camp, as well as any daily or weekly updates. Please check your Brightwheel account regularly during the summer for the most up-to-date information on your camper's summer experience.

Parent Email Addresses

Almost all of our communication with families comes through email or via our website. We must have a valid email address for the family of each registered camper. This is the only way to guarantee that you receive important announcements and updates from us. Also, please add info@rosenjcc.com to your address book or safe list to ensure that our emails will not be blocked as spam. If you are not certain that we have a correct email address for your family, please call our Welcome Center at 407.387.5330.

JCC Emails

Both the Rosen JCC and Camp J use special software to send emails to large numbers of people or groups. By having campers at Camp J, your family is part of the JCC community and will receive emails from both Camp J and the Rosen JCC. It is important that you do not "opt-out" of receiving JCC emails. Opting out of these emails will prevent you from receiving important information regarding Camp J programs, updates, and news. DROP OFF & PICK-UP

When you drop off your camper in the morning, simply park and escort them into the gym where they'll meet their group and check in with their counselors before kicking off their day of fun. All campers, Including those participating in camp plus swim, will be dropped off and picked up at the Rosen JCC. Transportation to and from the Rosen Aquatic Center will be provided.

For afternoon pick-ups, we've streamlined the process with a convenient carpool line. Our dedicated staff will guide you through the entrance off of Apopka-Vineland Rd to the oval in front of the building. Look out for signage in the parking lot directing parents/guardians where to go, and don't worry if you miss it – we'll also distribute an electronic map for your convenience.

To ensure a smooth and efficient process, we kindly ask that parents/guardians remain in their cars while our Rosen JCC staff members escort campers directly to your vehicle. Your child's safety and convenience are our top priorities!
