All camp registrations must be paid in full. Schedule changes are subject to availability and there is a \$25 fee per camper per week. To cancel a week of camp, a two-week written notice is required. While camp tuition is non-refundable, account credits may be issued on a case-by-case basis. Credits are valid for one year and can be applied to any JCC program. Same-day registrations will incur a \$50 fee. Lunches are non-refundable.


